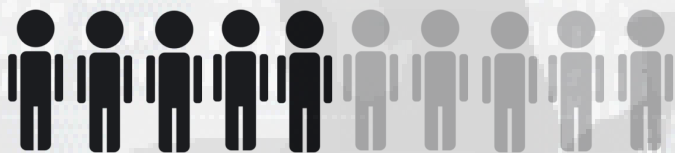

After decades of decline in manufacturing jobs, more Black workers are finding themselves unemployed or in low-paying service jobs. The construction industry is one that continues to provide good career opportunities. However, many Black construction workers are discriminated against and shut out from these jobs.



50% of Black Workers in Los Angeles Unemployed or Underemployed.

We are **9%** of the population of Los Angeles, but we only make up **4.9%** of the construction workforce.

When Black workers and families suffer, the nation suffers. There is no better time than now to take this crisis head-on. We need YOU to join the fight.
